At-Home Printmaking Supply List

At Home Cyanotype Printmaking Demonstration with Tamara Deedman

- Thick paper (such as a sketchbook, card stock paper, rag paper)
- Sheet of glass or plexi-glas with protected edges (could be from a picture frame and tape any sharp edges)
- Large cotton towel x 2
- Negatives for using to expose as your stencils/imagery (printed on transparencies using a laser or inkjet printer)
- Container (such as a tupperware or plastic container, yogurt tub, bowl, etc.)
- Measuring tool (such as a measuring spoon or cup)
- Clips/Clamps
- Utility knife
- Disposable vinyl/latex gloves ***Please ensure you wear gloves and eye protection when mixing chemistry!!
- Paint brushes or foam brushes
- Cyanotype Part A & B (can be purchased from most local art stores or from Jacquard)
- Basin for water
- The sun!!

*Please note you can substitute and try other materials and tools as you see fit or have available to you! Part of the joy of at-home printing is being creative with what you have!
